This position will participate in and be exposed to: fertility programs, IPM and pesticide applications, irrigation practices, equipment set-up, cultural practices, team supervision and daily golf course maintenance. The successful candidate will be able to recognize the importance of: contributing to a cohesive team environment; being an effective communicator; being efficient and organized; being a constant leader; supporting other Members of the Team; and providing service excellence to Members and guests at every opportunity.

1. **Golf Course Maintenance**
 - Assist in planning and supervising the daily golf course maintenance operations
 - Assist in all golf course related maintenance activities including cultural practices, operation/repair of the Rainbird irrigation system, and fertilizer and pesticide applications

- Be informed on the maintenance & repair of all equipment used for maintaining the golf course
- Assist in planning and supervising course construction projects
- Assist in the maintenance of tees, greens, fairways, rough and bunkers ensuring all areas are maintained to the highest standards
- Be informed of all course maintenance activities and be able to report progress
- Perform any other duties as assigned from time to time by the Superintendent or Assistant Superintendent
- Assume all duties of the Assistant Superintendent or Superintendent in their absence

2. Human Resources

- Assist in recruitment, hiring, and overseeing of the maintenance crew
- Report any activities or problems and participate in enforcing any remedial actions necessary to rectify the situation

3. Maintenance Reports

- Ensure fertilizer and pesticide records are completed correctly and in a timely manner
- Maintain daily logs and records related to maintenance activities
- Assist in the preparation of maintenance reports

- Adhere to the safety policies in place for Team Members, as well as Members and guests

- Assist in scheduling maintenance work to achieve the most efficient utilization of Team Members and equipment
- Assist and supervise Team Members ensuring maintenance standards are met and exceeded
